Location: Christie Conservation Area (1000 Hwy #5 West, RR #2, Dundas, ON. L9H 5E2)

Registration: from 10:00 am

Awards: Conclusion of the event

Eligibility: Open to all students registered in an Ontario elementary (Grade 6 and higher) or secondary school or invited guests from other jurisdictions. All entrants must be accompanied by an adult supervisor approved by the school or the school board represented.

Course Lengths and Categories: based on **Birth Year**

Bantam (2 km) 2005 & 2004
Junior (3 km) 2001 or later

Midget (2.2 km) 2003 & 2002 or later
Senior (4 km) 2000 – 1998 or later

Fees: \$8.00 per student.

Donation: This year a portion of each entry fee will be donated to **Ronald McDonald House**. Ronald McDonald House provides a “home-away-from-home” for the families of seriously ill children who are receiving treatment at McMaster University Hospital. Ronald McDonald Houses operate in 51 countries around the world while the Hamilton house was opened in 1993.

Volunteers: Each school must provide at least 1 volunteer to assist race organizers.

Entry Deadline: Organizers will preprint courses and package maps for entries received by **Tuesday April 18th**. Entrants after the deadline may have to copy from a master map after their start time.

**** Registration will be limited to a maximum of 70 starts per school ****

Format: Entrants will be started at one minute intervals on each course.

Map: Christie Lake. Scale 1:10,000 (1cm on map to 100 m on ground)

Facilities: Washrooms, bus/car parking, covered areas.

Rules:

1. All participants must carry an emergency safety whistle. **The emergency signal is 3 whistle blasts – repeated.**
2. Participate alone or in pairs as per entry. Pairs will be classed in the category of the older partner and / or the male partner in the case of mixed pairs. Triples accepted.
3. In the true spirit of Orienteering, participants are expected to make their own decisions regarding route choice. It is considered poor etiquette to follow others.
4. **No student** is allowed on the course before or after participating.

Registration Process

Registration will be done electronically. The registration form can be found by visiting the Dontgetlost Adventure Running website: www.dontgetlost.ca. From “Races” on the top menu bar, select “Schools Challenge”. Under Registration Process, click on “Download our registration spreadsheet”.

Save the registration form with an appropriate name and delete unwanted categories and insert rows as required. Note: Schools will not require all categories.
